 And, all of our mediation services are available free of charge to low-income residents.

We work with diverse groups of people who come together to create safe, inclusive communities that are free from violence, discrimination, harassment, and intergroup conflict. In just a year's time, we can:

- Reach over **25,000 students, staff, administrators, parents and community members** in partnership with schools from multiple Orange County districts.
- Unite over **600 students and teachers**, from over 30 schools, at our annual *Walk in My Shoes* Youth Conference.
- Graduate over **50 language-minority parents** in our *Parent Leadership Institute*.
- Train over 800 mediators in advanced mediation workshops.
- Provide free mediation services to over **5,500 residents**.
- Engage volunteers in over 11,800 hours of service.
